Contracts – The Heart and Soul of the Industry!

Contracts are the heart and soul of the oil and gas industry and this 1-day interactive course focuses on several of the most important contracts that impact the land professional. Group exercises help demonstrate why and when contracts are used and the challenges they may pose. This workshop highlights specific features and characteristics of AML's, Joint Venture Agreements, Surface Agreements, Seismic Agreements, Confidentiality Agreements, and financial agreements creating Production Payments. This practical, hands-on class will provide an understanding of contract law and is designed for all oil & gas professionals who work either directly or indirectly with contracts.

The JOA and the Land Professional

This course focuses on what may be the most common agreement for upstream oil and gas operations. The class will look at the history of the AAPL model form, its weaknesses and how to avoid problems with its use. Discussions will deal with the operator, joint operations, relationship and duties to non operators, joint operations under pooling and unitization, preferential purchase rights, liabilities of the parties, cost overruns, COPAS overhead litigation, loss of lease rights, failure to reassign subleased interests, recent appellant decisions, non-consent issues, and other risk management issues.
