### AAPL DIRECTOR'S REPORT

#### AAPL DIRECTOR'S REPORT FOR THE TULSA ASSOCIATION OF PETROLEUM LANDMEN

Savannah, Georgia – December 11, 2022

The AAPL Board Meeting was held at the JW Marriott in Phoenix, Arizona. The following notes are only a portion of the Board Meeting. Should any member like to discuss more in detail, then please feel free to reach out to me.

#### AAPL By The Numbers - Membership is down from this time last year but Associates continue to increase!

- At the time of this report, there are currently a little under 11,000 total members of AAPL, but membership is down roughly 2.91% from this time last year.
- 4,337 CPL's, RPL's, and RL's (with an additional 5,300 members that are eligible, but not certified)
- Associate Membership has continued to increase, with 917 members, which is up by 6.26% compared to last year and we have 351 Student Members which is down 17.41% from last year.
- 48% of our members are eligible for certification but have not applied.

#### **Education**

- The <u>Renewable Energy Certificate Program</u> is now live!
  - At the completion of all modules, a Renewable Energy Certificate will be issued. Continuing education is not required to maintain the certificate. <u>CLICK HERE</u> to learn more.
- AAPL RPL/CPL Certification Exam Review (Ft. Worth) is on March 8<sup>th</sup> 10<sup>th</sup>
- Online Testing for Certification has rolled out! Once your application has been approved, you'll simply need to schedule a time at your local Scantron location to sit for the exam.
- I'm still working with Robert Wilson (Field Landman Committee Chair) to bring a seminar to Tulsa.
- Complimentary education webinars are being held each quarter. These are not available for on-demand viewing, only live.
- Keep an eye out for the latest AAPL Education Seminars emailed periodically and found in the TAPL newsletters.
- Need Ethics Credits? AAPL has the new Ethics videos online at a low cost of \$50 per video.

The AAPL Board continues to be mindful of maintaining a balanced budget considering the current environment. The following are accounts associated with the AAPL and the dollar amounts as of 9/30/22:

- Total Assets = \$36,555,870 (down 18.3%, from \$44,730,072 as of 9/30/21)
- AAPL, Inc's Investment Accounts = \$30,343,671 (down 21.5%, from \$38,655,864 as of 9/30/21)
- AAPL Educational Foundation, Inc. = \$4,686,391 (down 16.3%, from \$5,596,503 as of 9/30/21)
- Landman Scholarship Trust = \$8,197,072 (down 18%, from \$9,995,884 as of 9/30/21)

- Social Media Growth: AAPL has seen a 179% increase in Twitter interactions! As well as a 25% and 18% increase in LinkedIn and Facebook, respectively.
- The "Path of the Landman" video is now available on AAPL's YouTube channel. CLICK HERE to view it.

- Our Government Affairs Committee is currently tracking <u>427 bills</u>, **30 of which are in Oklahoma**. This is a record number of bills they've ever tracked, analyzed, and reported on for members for legislatures in session. In addition, they are tracking 78 Federal/State Regulations and 17 Federal/State Judicial cases.
- The website has this federal and state bill tracking information. It's updated monthly very good information.

The newly updated Oil & Gas Law Book has been released, and sales have generated ~\$49,000 in revenue.

- AAPL Staff changes: Barbara Reyes (Administrative Assistant) and Brandon Hart (Instructional Design Association) both resigned from AAPL. Please join me in wishing them all the best.


