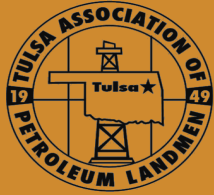

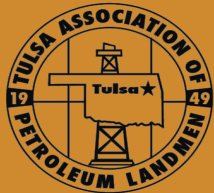

### PETROTECH TRAINING PROGRAM



#### PetroTech Technical Training Program.

When people learn that you are a landman, the initial response is often, “Landman? What do you do?” Next comes the follow-up question: “How could I learn to be a landman?”

These questions prompted me to contact the Oklahoma Energy Resources Board (OERB) and to explain the need for a how-to-become-a-field-landman’s class. OERB quickly recognized the need for such a class due to the shortage of field landmen. As a result, OERB and Francis Tuttle Career Technology Center agreed to add a “Land and Lease Management” class to the OERB PetroTech- nical Training Program. This 15-hour course begins in January 2024, and focuses on the interrelated, industry roles: Land Broker, Landman, Land Tech, Lease and Title Analyst, and Division Order An- alyst.

The “Land and Lease Management” course is ideal for energetic, motivated people who are excited about learning more about the oil and gas industry and basic field land work but may not be interest- ed in pursuing an energy management degree. 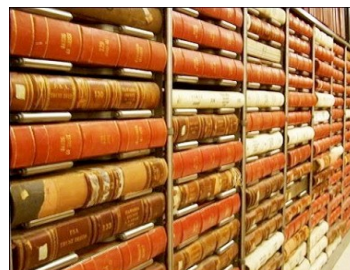

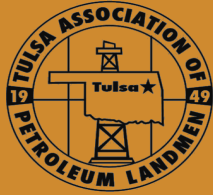
